

1.2 – Angels and Archetypes

1.2.1 – **Angels**: Date: before 12th century

1 a : a spiritual being superior to humans in power and intelligence; *especially* : one in the lowest rank in the celestial hierarchy **b plural** : an order of angels — see [CELESTIAL HIERARCHY](#)

2 : an attendant spirit or guardian

3 : a usually white-robed winged figure of human form in fine art

4 : [MESSENGER](#), [HARBINGER](#) <angel of death>

5 : a person like an angel (as in looks or behavior)

6 *Christian Science* : inspiration from God

7 : one (as a backer of a theatrical venture) who aids or supports with money or influence

8 : [ANGELFISH](#)

1.2.2 – **Archetypes**: Date: 1545

1 : the original pattern or model of which all things of the same type are representations or copies : [PROTOTYPE](#); *also* : a perfect example

2 : [IDEA](#) 1a

3 : an inherited idea or mode of thought in the psychology of C. G. Jung (Carl Gustav 1875–1961 Swiss psychologist) www.cgjungpage.org/
